

**TOWN OF GREENWOOD  
MONTHLY BOARD MEETING  
MINUTES  
February 10, 2025**

The monthly board meeting for the Town of Greenwood was called to order by Chairman Mitchell Peters at 7:01 PM. All members present. Also present were residents Mike Judnic and Michael Radtke.

**Minutes** - Minutes were read by Clerk Jill Scheithauer. A motion was made by Sup. Michael Wudi and seconded by Mitch to accept the minutes of the January meeting. Motion passed.

**Treasurer's Report/Pay Bills** – A motion was made by Mike to pay the bills and accept the treasurer's report. Second by Travis. Motion passed. Jill brought up the Wex Mobil credit card asking if it can be paid upon receipt as we were getting charged \$75 late fees because they were not receiving it by the due date. It was decided to cancel that credit card due to no longer needing it.

**Public Input** – Michael Radtke was present to ask what can be done about Jim Schreiner's property. He has moved from the property but is still hauling garbage there. Michael indicating he now has rats at his house and his aunt had the same thing. Mitch offered to contact the Sheriff's Department and find out what can be done and he will contact Michael with an update.

**Road Updates** – Graderman Kurt Bube has been busy plowing snow. Kurt got the plexiglass for the grader protection and will be installing it soon. Snowmobile club is wanting to use Illman South and a little bit of Illman North. It's been decided they can use it. The idea is to leave a little snow in the ditch on Illman south on the east side of the road where they can use the ditch and the shoulder.

Debbie Fuchs contacted Mitch about an ordinance plowing snow across the road. She provided a statute saying it's illegal. Mitch is going to contact the Sheriff's Department to determine if there is anything that we can do about it as a township.

We have a town resident that lives on a road in the Town of Chelsea. Chelsea is responsible for plowing that road. Mitch received a complaint from that resident about the road not being plowed out. Mitch contacted the WTA about snowplowing procedures required of a township. He was told by law that a township is not "required" to plow snow for up to 3 weeks after a storm before it can be found liable. In addition, they are only required clear a passable lane.

**Other Business:**

**Logs in Ditch on Wood Creek Avenue** – there is wood in the ditch near Hank Blennert's land on Wood Creek Avenue. It has been there for over 5 years now. Jill to send a letter to Eric Zastrow to remove the wood by June 1, 2025. If it is not removed by that date, it will be removed by the town at his expense.

**Recycling Commission** – The Village of Rib Lake is considering closing down the recycling center and going to curbside pickup. If that happens, we will be responsible for providing recycling for our residents. It is the consensus that we as a township would like to keep the recycling commission together and keep the recycling center open.

A motion was made by Travis, seconded by Mike to adjourn the meeting at 7:48 PM. Next meeting to be held on March 12, 2025. Meeting adjourned.
