

**TOWN OF GREENWOOD
MONTHLY BOARD MEETING
MINUTES
March 12, 2025**

The monthly board meeting for the Town of Greenwood was called to order by Chairman Mitchell Peters at 7:03 PM. All members present except Sup. Travis Fuchs.

Minutes - Minutes were read by Clerk Jill Scheithauer. A motion was made by Mitch and seconded Sup. Michael Wudi to accept the minutes of the February meeting. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report/Pay Bills – A motion was made by Mike to pay the bills and accept the treasurer's report. Second by Mitch. Motion passed.

Public Input – None. As a follow up to Michael Radtke's visit to the meeting of last month, Mitch contacted the Sheriff's Department. Because we have no ordinance, there is nothing we can do about the garbage on the Jim Schreiner property. The surrounding neighbors will have to call in complaints to the Sheriff's Department to enforce anything.

Road Updates – Graderman Kurt Bube has been grading and unclogging culverts. He is asking about installing the big culverts on River Road (near Edelberg property) and Evergreen (near Holzl property). Mitch is going to check on the pricing. Given the size of these culverts, the cost is shared with the County. It is suggested for the board and Kurt to do another road trip to check the town roads for culvert conditions and gravel needs.

Gravel Bids – It was decided to repeat the specs and ad from last year, 7000 +/- yards of $\frac{3}{4}$. Jill to get ad submitted.

Dust Control – Mitch will contact Taylor County Highway for a price on their dust control. Kafka normally submits a bid in April.

Other Business – Jill will be working on the annual report and will email it for approval. It will need to be signed before April 1, 2025 so copies are available to residents at the Spring Election.

A motion was made by Mitch, seconded by Mike to adjourn the meeting at 7:43 PM. Next meeting to be held on April 9, 2025. Meeting adjourned.
