

**TOWN OF GREENWOOD  
MONTHLY BOARD MEETING  
MINUTES  
April 9, 2025**

The monthly board meeting for the Town of Greenwood was called to order by Chairman Mitchell Peters at 7:00 PM. All members present.

**Minutes** - Minutes were read by Clerk Jill Scheithauer. A motion was made by Sup. Mike Wudi and seconded Mitch to accept the minutes of the March meeting. Motion passed.

**Treasurer's Report/Pay Bills** – We received the disaster relief funds in the amount of \$31,471.71. It was decided to move that money to the money market account for now to gain additional interest. A motion was made by Sup. Travis Fuchs to pay the bills and accept the treasurer's report. Second by Mike. Motion passed.

**Public Input** – None.

**Gravel Bids** – Only one bid received for gravel, Haas & Sons, Inc., at the rate of \$9.95/ton to equal \$14.93/yard (roughly \$224/load). Private residents can purchase for \$10.95/ton (roughly \$246/load). The private resident amount is only valid while Haas is hauling the town's gravel. Motion by Mike and seconded by Travis to accept Haas' bid.

**Other Quotes** – J.J.'s Brushcutting submitted a bid for mowing grass at \$75/hour and brushing at the rate of \$90/hour. It was agreed to table the grass mowing until next month to see if any other bids come in. Kafka submitted a bid for dust control at the rate of \$1.51/gallon for calcium chloride. Taylor County Highway quoted \$1.40/calcium chloride. Last year TC Highway quoted the same thing, but our bill came back at \$1.25 meaning they passed their savings on to us. They believe we will need about 14 loads. Mitch motions to hire the highway to do dust control and Travis seconds. Motion passed.

**Road Updates** – Graderman Kurt Bube advised the air compressor is dying and will need to get a replacement. Mitch has a used compressor that he is willing to let Kurt try it for a month and if it works, he will sell it to the town. If it doesn't work, we will find something else. Mike motions and Travis seconds to try Mitch's compressor on a trial basis. Motion passed. Mitch is to still ask the Highway Dept. about the cost of the big culverts we need for River Road and Evergreen.

**Other Business** – Travis advised the board the Janak & Sons has the bid to update the school remodel and is asking to have access to Wellington Lake Drive to access a sandpit on Obenhoffer's land in the Town of Greenwood. It was decided as a board to deny access to WLD given the Class B status of our road and will be suggesting they use Evergreen.

A motion was made by Travis and seconded by Mike to adjourn the meeting at 7:38 PM. Next meeting to be held on May 14, 2025. Meeting adjourned.
