

**Town of Greenwood
Monthly Board Meeting
Minutes
October 8, 2025**

The monthly board meeting for the Town of Greenwood was called to order by Chairman Mitchell Peters at 7:00 pm. All board members were present along with clerk Jill Scheithauer, and treasurer Linda Bartelt. Graderman Kurt Bube not present.

Minutes- The minutes for the September 10, 2025 meeting were read by Jill. A motion was made by Supervisor Travis Fuchs and seconded by Supervisor Mike Wudi to approve the minutes from the September meeting. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report/Pay Bills- Linda updated the board about some issues with Nicolet National Bank. The treasurer's report was presented by Linda. A motion was made by Travis and seconded by Mike to approve the treasurer's report and pay the monthly bills. Motion passed.

Proposed Budget – There will be a 5% increase in fire dues going from \$19,500 to \$20,475. Next month is the budget meeting. Jill will update the board before the meeting with any updates.

Public Input- None

Road Updates- Kurt was able to bury a culvert on Wellington Lake Drive (Brian Lennartz property). We will be getting a bill from the Highway Department, which will be billed to Lennartz for reimbursement.

Joint Recycling – The Village of Rib Lake has chosen to withdraw from the Joint Recycling Committee leaving both the Town of Greenwood and Town of Rib Lake left to decide how to proceed in the future. Mitch has done some extensive research on options of either offering recycling for the Town of Greenwood solely or joining forces with the Town of Rib Lake. There was extended conversation on the options of how to move forward: (1) go independent and set up something at the Greenwood town hall; (2) combine with the Town of Rib Lake to continue working out of the recycling center located in the Village of Rib Lake (this second option would only be feasible if there is no payout to the Village of Rib Lake). A possibility could be to sell the facility and split the proceeds three ways. It was suggested that an audit be performed on all the recycling commission's books.

A conference call took place with the Town of Rib Lake starting at 8:04 PM. Both townships feel there is not enough money to pay the Village of Rib Lake anything for their third for leaving. The bylaws are not clear. Both towns agree that the books should be audited. To do that is to call a special meeting of the commission for the purpose of audit.

Mitch motions for the Town of Greenwood to request an audit from the Joint Recycling Commission to help determine the feasibility of maintaining the recycling center without the Village of Rib Lake. Travis seconds. Motion passed.

Other Business- None.

A motion was made by Mike and seconded by Travis to adjourn at 8:35 PM. Motion passed.
